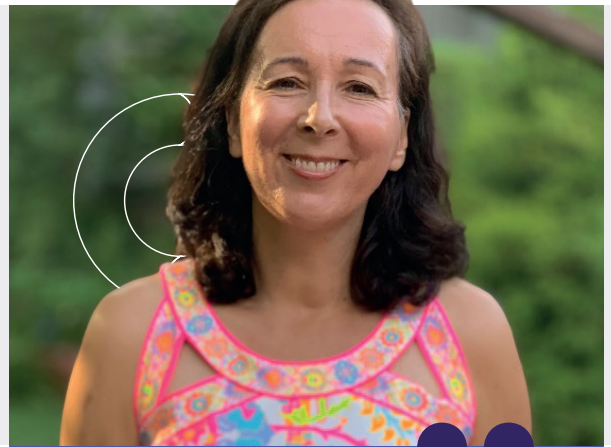


Meet the expert
